Five (5) Days before Procedure: <u>DO NOT</u> take any aspirin or ibuprofen products. Tylenol (acetaminophen) is allowed. •

- DO NOT DRINK ALCOHOL FOR (5) DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE. •
- Stop taking Anticoagulants or blood thinners, such as: Coumadin, Xarelto, Plavix, Pradaxa or Eliquis, if necessary we will request cardiac clearance.

Day before Procedure:

- Follow a clear liquid diet throughout the day. Items include: water, clear juices without • pulp (clear apple juice), clear soda (ginger-ale, sprite, 7up), chicken or beef broth, popsicles, Jell-O, tea, coffee, etc. If you are diabetic, drink regular (non-diet) liquids in moderation throughout the day.
- Avoid Food, dairy products, orange juice and dark colored liquids with red, purple and blue dye.
- Step 1: At _____ pour one of the 6-ounce bottles of SUPREP into the mixing container • provided in your prep kit.
- **Step 2**: Add cold water to the fill line of the 16--ounce container and mix. •
- **Step 3**: Drink all of the liquid in the container.
- Step 4: IMPORTANT You must drink two more 16-ounce containers of water over the next hour.
- YOU MAY CONTINUE WITH CLEAR LIQUIDS UNTIL MIDNIGHT.
- DO NOT DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT.

Day of Procedure:

- Take any currently prescribed heart or blood pressure medications with a <u>sip</u> of water. ٠
- If you are diabetic: To avoid dangerously low blood sugar, please do not take your diabetic medication (pills or insulin) the morning of your procedure. You can resume yourdiabetes medications after the procedure once you have eaten.
- Plan on being at the facility for approximately 2 hours. ٠
- A driver must accompany you to the facility; they must stay in the facility the entire time of your procedure.
- YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE OR TAKE A CAB.
